Known for its stunning red-rock buttes, steep canyon walls and pine forests, the city also boasts a vibrant arts community with galleries and shopping.

Price for the 2 ½ -day, 3-night program includes luxury home rental with a hot tub, breakfast and lunch meals, and optional hikes each day for a range of ability-levels.

For an additional fee, a full-day, guided tour of the Grand Canyon's South Rim - one of the seven natural wonders of the world - can be added to your trip with a licensed company based out of Flagstaff, Arizona.

MEALS

Breakfast and pack-your-own lunch ingredients are included. Dinner, whether it is group-prepared cuisine or restaurant dining, will be decided by the group and will be pay-on-your-own. Please bring your own alcohol. Let us know if you have a restricted diet or allergies.

TRAVEL

You are responsible for getting to the rental property. We encourage carpooling, as there is limited on-site parking. Street parking is not allowed per city ordinance. Approximate driving time from Tempe to Sedona is 2 hours and is an increase in elevation to 4,350 feet. In fall, Sedona temperatures are an average high of 75 and low of 50 degrees. Pack a bathing suit for a dip in the hot tub!

Check-in is Monday at 4:00 pm, and check-out is Thursday at 10:00 am.

Whenever you would like, you can add on an 8-hour, small group bus tour of the South Rim with **Grand Canyon Adventures** (www.dothecanyon.com). Picnic-style lunch is included, as well as park entrance fees. Your professional guide will stop at historical landmarks, scenic outcrops and the Tusayan Geology Museum.

Depart from the Flagstaff tour office at 8:15 am and return by 5:00 pm. There is ample parking at the tour office for your rental car. Flagstaff is approximately a 1-hour drive from Sedona.

Elevation at Flagstaff and the Grand Canyon is 7,000 feet. (Point-of-reference, Mussoorie is 6,578 feet.) We strongly recommend wearing warm layers and bringing a winter jacket.
